Dear Parent/Guardian

We hope you had a nice summer holiday and we would like to take this opportunity to welcome you back to EEIS Saturday Al-Kauthar Madrasah. We pray that Allah makes this a beneficial year for students, staff and parents.

This letter is just to remind you of some key points and events related to the Madrasah.

- i. Madrasah begins promptly at **10.30am till after Zuhr. Students are required to pray before they leave.** Please bring your child/ren 5 – 10 minutes before so they can settle in. Students will be allowed to go home after praying Zuhr Jamaat. Due to security reasons, Doors to the Masjid will be locked at 10.45am and will be opened prior to Zuhr Salah. The Masjid is not responsible for any children before 10.30am and after Zuhr Salah. Please park responsibly and safely on the side roads without disturbing our neighbours, by blocking driveways, when dropping and picking your children up from the Masjid. We advise leaving home early to find parking.
- ii. Students will have a short 10 minute break during Madrasah for which they are allowed to bring drinks and snacks. Students **can also bring a bottle of water with them to have during class.**
- iii. Boys should be collected from the main prayer hall or main entrance. Girls should be collected from the side entrance. Students should not go home after the salah without a teacher's permission. A written note must be given for elder students who wish to go home on their own.
- iv. **Madrasah Parents Morning: Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2021 10.30am till 11.30pm. This will be an opportunity to learn about our syllabus and expectations we have of students and parents, meet your class teacher for the next year and ask any questions you may have. Students should remain in class after the meeting and can leave after Zuhr Salah.**
- v. Uniform: Boys should wear white thobe/kurta/shirt and a hat. Girls should wear black abayah with white hijab headscarf.
- vi. Please fulfil payment of the fees promptly. New students: £225 including administration fees. Existing students £215. This can be paid in cash (preferred), cheque or card. Once the students have been assessed and allocated to their new classes they will be given their new homework diaries and books.
- vii. Contact details: For environmental care we are trying to be paperless as much as we can. Please ensure you have a valid working email address as our correspondence throughout the year will be mainly electronic.
